

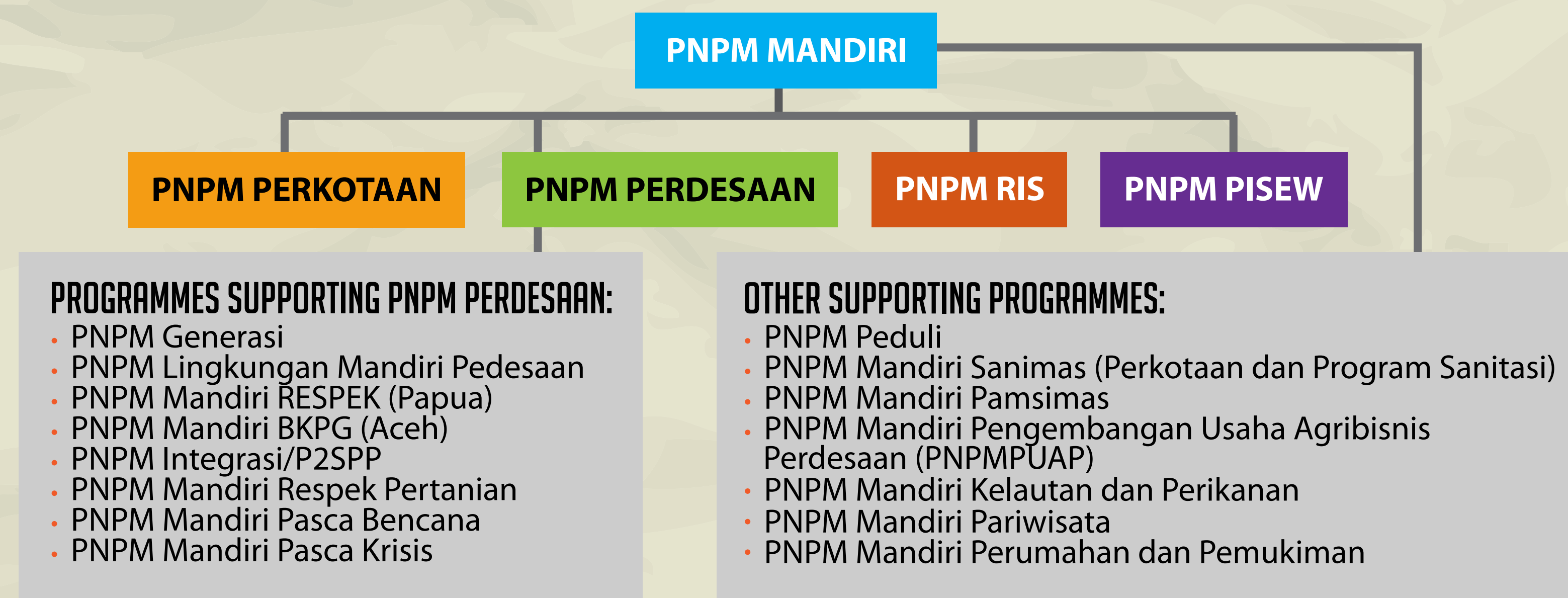
STRENGTHENING THE NATIONAL COMMUNITY EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMME (PNPM)

PNPM Mandiri is a government poverty reduction programme that uses policy frameworks as the basis and reference for implementing community empowerment poverty alleviation programmes.

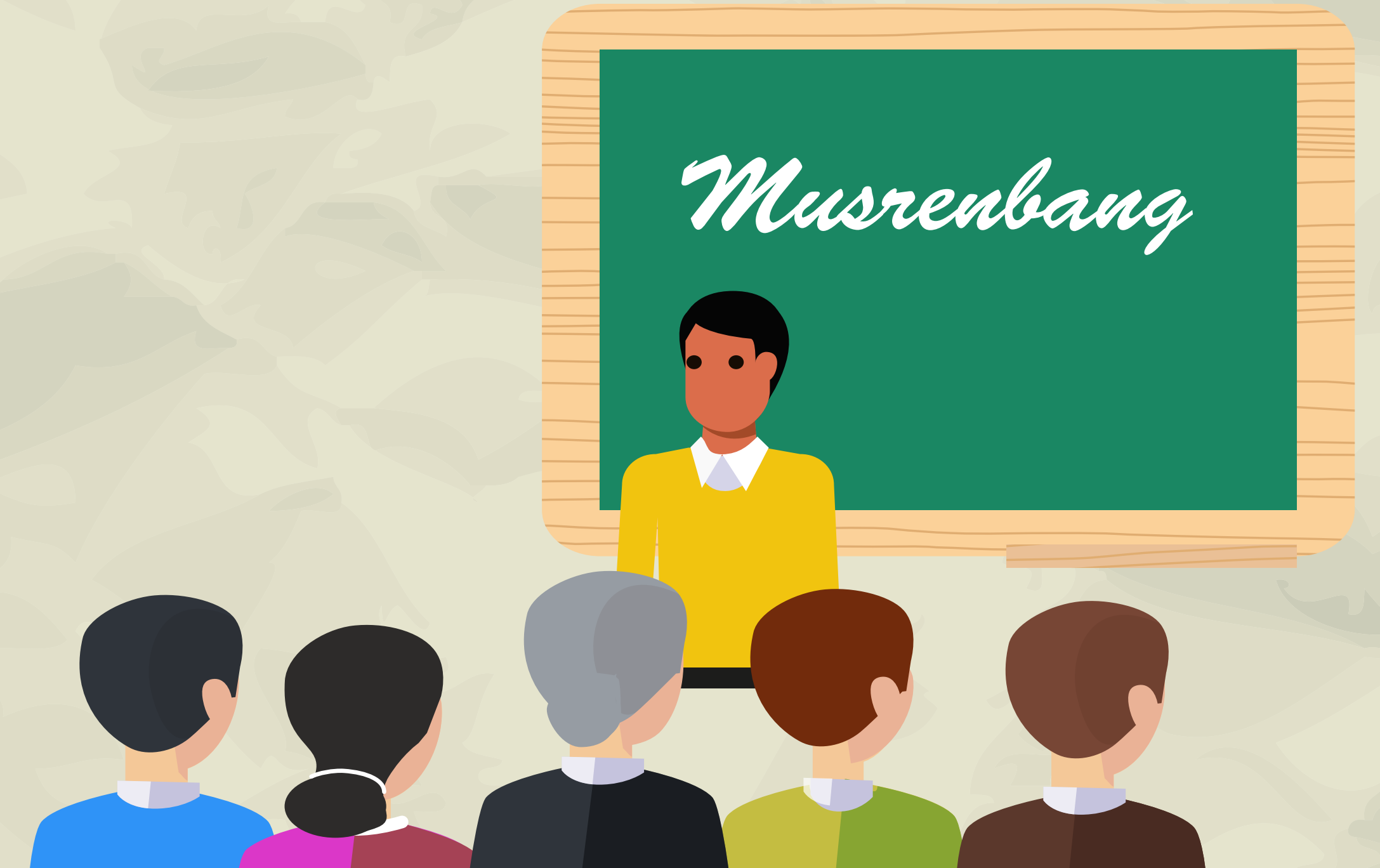
PNPM Mandiri involves the development of programme systems, mechanisms and procedures, the provision of guidance and funding to encourage initiatives and innovation as part of efforts towards continued poverty reduction.

CHALLENGES

1 With the development of numerous community empowerment programmes -- both with and without the PNPM name --, multiple programme procedures have developed. This causes confusion and impacts the effectiveness of PNPM Mandiri implementation and its target achievements.



2 Community empowerment efforts are ideally carried out by PNPM as part of development activities and village planning, and by development planning councils (Musrenbang) and others.



ROLES OF TNP2K

01 CREATE A ROADMAP AND WORK AGENDA

Together with PNPM's Control Working Group at the Office of the Coordination Ministry for People's Welfare, the Ministry of Home Affairs, the Ministry of Public Works and Bappenas, a roadmap was created, which was used to develop 12 work agendas.



FIVE PILLARS OF THE ROADMAP POLICY

The roadmap has five pillars that relevant government bodies and stakeholders can use to build mutual commitments towards sustainable and effective community empowerment and poverty reduction programmes in Indonesia.

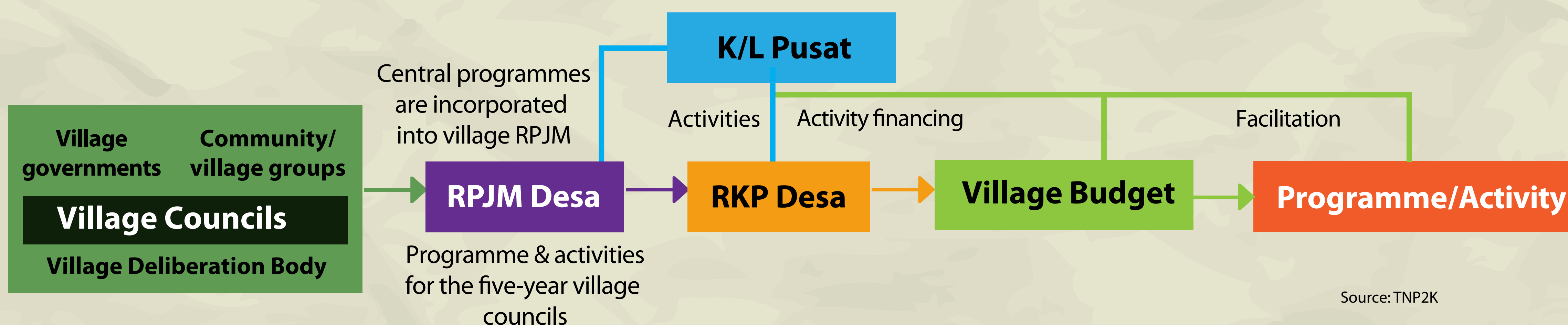

02 PROMOTE LEGAL BASES FOR PRINCIPLES, MECHANISMS GOVERNANCE AND PROCEDURES

In line with Law Number 6 of 2011 on Villages (*Undang-Undang Desa*), community empowerment activities will be conducted on a continual basis. PNPM principles, mechanisms, governance and procedures will be refined so that they are carried out in the context of the law on villages. The 12 work agendas in PNPM Mandiri's roadmap serve as instruments during the transitional period ahead of the implementation of the law on villages, and fully empower communities to implement development in their villages.
